The Malta Police Union obtained a favorable recommendation in its claim for Police officers to wear baseball cap whilst on beach patrol.

After the Malta Police Union registered a Trade Dispute on the 4th June 2021 after its request for Police Officers to wear their police issued baseball cap whilst on beach patrol have not been positively met.

In terms of the provisions of the Collective Agreement 2017-2024, a conciliatory meeting was held where the panel recommended in favor of the request of the Union and therefore, those officers who will be detailed to perform beach patrol, will wear the police baseball cap instead of the normal every day cap.

This was the first time that this procedure has been adopted by a Police Union, showing that once again, the Malta Police Union acts promptly and in the adequate fora to protect its members.

The Union thanks the panel and the members of the Police Force who attended the meeting for their professionalism.

We remind our member that if whilst on duty with the normal uniform and their action is required on the beach or at any other similar location, these are to intervene with their working uniform at the time.
